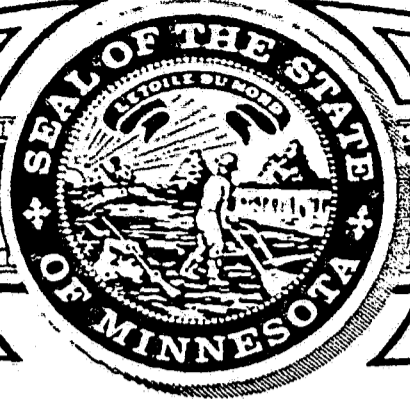


STATE OF MINNESOTA
