HEREAS: The state conferences, branches, youth councils and college chapters in each state will also participate in this Diamond Jubilee celebration; and

IEREAS: During the seventy-five year history of the NAACP, the Association has worked unremittingly within the system to achieve equal opportunity and justice for all citizens;
