WHEREAS: Many thousands of veterans of America's Armed Forces have served this nation in times of both peace and war, and in doing so have thereby assured the safety and prosperity of all her people as this nation enters its third century of independence; and

WHEREAS: More than 90,000 veterans are hospitalized in medical centers nationwide; and

WHEREAS: The Veterans Administration, for the eleventh consecutive year, has organized national programs of tribute honoring all hospitalized veterans, with the purpose of urging all americans to remember these men and women especially during this week and throughout the year; and

WHEREAS: We wish to express to the patients in the Minneapolis VA Medical Center our concern, care and sincere appreciation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 13 through February 17, 1984, to be
