WHEREAS: The people of the State of Minnesota recognize the valuable contributions of the surveying profession to history, development and quality of life in the State of Minnesota and the United States of America; and

WHEREAS: The surveying profession requires special education, training, experience, and knowledge of the principles of mathematics, the related physical and applied sciences, and requirements of law for adequate evidence; and

WHEREAS: Surveyors are uniquely qualified and licensed to determine and describe land and water boundaries for the management of our natural resources and protection of private property rights; and

WHEREAS: President Regan has signed into law a resolution of the Congress of the United States authorizing the proclamation of the week beginning on March 11, 1984, as "National Surveyors Week";

NOW, THEREFORE, I Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 11 through March 17, 1984, to be
