- WHEREAS:** The cornerstone of Minnesotas economic recovery and the long term future to a stable economy is our education training system; and
- WHEREAS:** Economic development and the vitality of Minnesota are dependent on well-trained, technologically up-to-date workers; and
- WHEREAS:** Individual growth and freedoms are enhanced and protected through Vocational-Technical Education; and
- WHEREAS:** Business, industry, labor, and agriculture contribute greatly to the benefit directly from strong programs of Vocational-Technical Education; and
- WHEREAS:** Strong state and local leadership and support are needed to ensure that vocational needs of citizens at the high school, Area Vocational-Technical Institute, and adult levels are being met; and
