WHEREAS: The high technology/data processing industry is deeply involved in furthering the

development of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: High technology/data processing companies contribute significantly to the economy of, and are a major employer for, the State of Minnesota and its citizens; and

WHEREAS: High technology/data processing education is an area of major commitment for these companies and for schools, colleges and universities in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Three professional organizations, the Data Processing Management Association, Association of Computing Machinery and Association of Systems Management, promote

the interests of the industry and the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The objectives of these organizations and the high technology/data processing industry will be achieved by the upcoming 21st annual Northwest Computer Vendor Show and 6th annual Minnesota Joint Computer Conference; and
