METROPOLITAN AIRPORTS COMMISSION

ORDINANCE NO. 62

An Ordinance to promote and conserve public safety, health, peace, convenience and welfare, by regulating the use of the public properties owned by or under the supervision and control of the Metropolitan Airports Commission; prohibiting the idling of motor vehicles in the public passenger terminal area; and amending Commission Ordinance No. 59 by adding subdivision 4.7.

The Metropolitan Airports Commission does ordain:

Section 1 - Commission Ordinance No. 59 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection 4.7:

"4.7 No vehicle shall be permitted to idle its motor on any street, road, highway or parking area adjacent to the public passenger terminal building where a sign is posted prohibiting such idling."

Section 2 - In all other respects Commission Ordinance No. 59 remains in full force and effect.

Section 3 - Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the filing of the same with proof of publication with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
