ORDINANCE #2 1983

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF
MAHNOMEN TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY BERNICE
ARENS ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the territory described below is not presently within the corporate limits of any incorporated City;

WHEREAS, this territory abutts the corporate limits of the City and is deemed to be urban or surburban in character; and

WHEREAS, Bernice Arens has petitioned the City of Mahmomen to Annex said property;

The City Council of Mahnomen, Minnesota ordains:

Section 1, Territory annexed, The corporate limits of the City of Mahnomen, Minnesota are hereby extended to includ the unplatted property described as follows:

Beginning at a point 33 feet more or less West and 5 feet North more or less from the Southeast Corner of the NE% SE% Section 3-144-42 West, being the point of intersection of the Right of Way line of a County Road therebeing and the North Right of Way line of the so called Cemetary Road therebeing, said point of intersection being marked by an iron stake, Thence North along and upon the West Right of Way Line of said County Road, 618 feet more or less to the point of beginning of the tract to be described; Thence West 209 feet more or less; Thence North 100 feet more or less; Thence East 209 feet more or less to the West Right of Way line of said County Road therebeing. Thence South along and upon the West Right of Way line of said County Road 100 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

Said tract being part of the NE% SE% Section 3-144-42

Section 2. Filing. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Mahnomen County; the Town Clerk of Pembina Township and the Minnesota Municipal Board.

Section 3. Effective date of annexation. This ordinance takes effect upon passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 2.

ORDINANCE

(3) Said newspaper has 50 percent of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75 percent of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Mahnomen in the County of Mahnomen and it has its known office of issue in the City of Managemen in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper is made available at single or subscription prices to any person, corporation, partnership or other unincorporated association requesting the newspaper and making the applicable payment. (8) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (9) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
