- REAS: We as citizens of Minnesota enjoy the freedoms conferred by our democratic form of government; and
- REAS: We demonstrate pride in our heritage by a high level of patriotism and support for our national laws; and
- REAS: We believe in strong military preparedness to safeguard our freedoms; and
- REAS: The Selective Service System has been directed to assist in the process of improving our readiness posture by calling upon eighteen year old male citizens to identify themselves by registering their name, address, date of birth, and social security number with that system at the Post Office within thirty days of their date of birth; and
- REAS: There is a severe penalty for failure to register;

, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April, 1984, to be
