WHEREAS: SPAN is the oldest independent study abroad program in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: SPAN, during the last three decades, has sent over 1400 Minnesota college and university students for summer study abroad after having received extensive training in language, history and culture of the host country; and

WHEREAS: SPAN has contributed to the world awareness of Minnesota citizens by service, interest and involvement; and

WHEREAS: SPAN has been an important means of building goodwill between the United States and other nations of the world by promoting international education;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 25, 1984, to be
