WHEREAS: The critical significance of the care and experiences of children from infancy through their early school years is increasingly recognized; and

WHEREAS: By birth, every child in this nation is entitled:

To respect for himself - "as and for what he is";

To love, security and encouragement from a stable home;

To health and nutrition to insure his optimal physical and mental development;

To protection from physical dangers and moral hazards by a community which plans for its children's needs;

To programs which stimulate and facilitate children's fullest intellectual development - which builds on children's interest to experiment and discover things about themselves, other people and the ever-broadening world into which they move;

To concern, stimulation and guidance from all adults in their lives - their parents, their teachers and others who are competent, sensitive and supportive in their roles;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 1 through April 7, 1984, to be
