WHEREAS: The National Archives of the United States was established in 1934 to bring together the historical records of the Federal Government to preserve and make them available to the public; and

WHEREAS: The National Archives grew and developed over the years into the National Archives and Records Service to include Federal Records Centers, Presidential Libraries, and the Regional Branches of the National Archives bringing American cultural heritage closer to the populace and in particular to the citizens of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Genealogists, historians, and people from all walks of life have visited facilities of the National Archives and used the resources therein to pursue their own family history or to probe into the depths of our nation's past;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, June 19, 1984, to be
