EREAS: Minnesota's technology-based companies have provided a strong source of jobs and income for the state; and

- EREAS: Technology-intensive companies within the manufacturing sector in 1980 accounted for wages, salaries and proprietors income in excess of 4 billion dollars in Minnesota; and
- EREAS: The seed bed for the emergence of similar companies in the future must be nurtured and cultivated if this record of accomplishment is to continue;
