- EREAS: Michael Green began his career in law enforcement as a police officer with the Minneapolis Police Department on March 13, 1972; and
- EREAS: He consistently displays a sensitive and professional attitude in the performance of his duties; and
- EREAS: Officer Green received the departmental Medal of Valor for his courageous action on December 17, 1983, whereby Officer Green engaged in the exchange of gunfire with a felony suspect who was fatally wounded; and
- EREAS: Officer Green has been recommended on five separate occasions for departmental commendations for his outstanding performance which has resulted in the arrest of felony suspects; and
- EREAS: On March 21, the Minnesota Chief's of Police Association is honoring Officer Michael Green by presenting him with the "Police Officer of the Year" award for 1983;
