WHEREAS: The credit granters and credit reporting companies of St. Paul and Minneapolis, in cooperation with credit granters throughout the State of Minnesota, are observing National Consumer Credit Education Week in the spirit of free enterprise in America; and

WHEREAS: These consumer credit executives are also celebrating National Consumer Credit Education Week with emphasis upon the theme, "Credit - Investment in your Future", and
