



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Twin City Society of X-Ray Technicians met on March 8, 1938, to accept the Bylaws and Constitution for the American Society of Radiologic Technologists, so that all affiliated societies of Radiologic Technologists would be established would be established with a uniform foundation; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Society of Radiologic Technologists, composed of the 47 members of the former Twin City X-Ray Technicians and the Arrowhead Society was formally recognized as an affiliated society of the American Society of Radiologic Technologists on the 19th day of December 1938; and

WHEREAS: The 3000-plus Registered Radiologic Technologists of the State of Minnesota have recognized the need of continued professional growth and education and the exchange of technical information in the interest of better patient care; and

WHEREAS: The dedication of these people has stood as testimony of their concern for improved patient care through radiation protection, continuing education and the need for exchange of information for 46 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 23 through September 29, 1984, to be

FURTHER, I urge citizens to acknowledge the dedicated Technologists who live and work in our state.
