



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Women's American ORT pledges itself once again to the expansion of the global ORT (Organization for Rehabilitation through Training) network of vocational and technical education; to doubling the ORT-Israel network and to the establishment of the net international ORT school in Carmiel in the Galilee; to defeating anti-Semitism everywhere; to supporting the rights of Soviet Jews and human rights all over the world; to supporting the people of Israel in their search for peace and security; to developing the Bramson ORT Technical Institute in New York City and to establishing the new Los Angeles ORT Technical Institute, and to furthering the cause of quality public education for all citizens and working for revitalized and upgraded vocational and technical education in America; and

WHEREAS: Women's American ORT, the largest membership group in the 40-nation ORT family, has pledged itself once again -- as ORT moves into its 104th year of belief in "education power" -- to enroll tens of thousands of new members in order for the organization to achieve its goal of relevant, high-caliber education necessary for democratic society;
