



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Recognizing the tremendous importance of a comprehensive approach to medical care, the American Holistic Medical Association was founded in 1978 to foster a cooperative relationship among all those involved in health care -- physicians, health care professionals, and patients; and
- WHEREAS: To emphasize the importance of examining life styles and other aspects of patient choice in relationship to health and illness, the American Holistic Medical Association sponsors education and scientific programs designed to stress the necessity to look at patient care as encompassing the body, mind, spirit, emotions, and environment -- and to focus on patient responsibility for good, wholesome, personal health habits; and
- WHEREAS: The Surgeon General of the United States of America in 1979 emphasized the importance of changing personal habits and life style to improve the health of the American people; and
- WHEREAS: The American Holistic Medical Association, meeting at the Olive W. Garvey Center for the Improvement of Human Functioning, Wichita, Kansas, May 31 through June 3, 1984, is working to provide health professionals and the lay public with techniques to improve their health and life styles;
