- HEREAS: The rehabilitation and training of disabled Americans is a goal worthy of the support of all the citizens of Minnesota; and
- HEREAS: Such rehabilitation requires a sophisticated, modern program of vocational testing, counseling, guidance, work experience, and job placement services; and
- HEREAS: National Goodwill Industries has been providing all these essential services for 83 years, making it possible for thousands of disabled persons to become self-sufficient, contributing members of society; and
- HEREAS: Goodwill Industries, Inc. has affiliated with the National Easter Seal Society to join together their 65 year traditions of service to form Goodwill Industries, Inc./Easter Seal Society of Minnesota in order to maximize services available to Minnesota residents with disabilities; and
- HEREAS: May 6 through May 12, has been set aside as National Goodwill Week to encourage public support for the rehabilitation programs of Goodwill Industries throughout the country;
