



Proclamation

- REAS: The month of May is being observed throughout the Nation as Mental Health Month; and
- REAS: 75 years ago the first citizen-based mental health movement was established; and
- REAS: This movement has grown into the nationwide Mental Health Association; and
- REAS: The Mental Health Association of Minnesota, a citizen-volunteer advocacy organization, and its county chapters, are calling attention during May to its mission of promoting mental health, assisting in preventing mental illness, and improving upon the care and treatment of the mentally ill; and
- REAS: The Association and its chapters are also calling attention during May to measures which must be taken to keep our state in the forefront of the fight against mental illness; and
- REAS: Such measures include the promotion of appropriate and adequate standards of care, assisting the mentally ill and their families in gaining their legal and civil rights, educating the general public about mental health issues and concerns, and helping to stimulate a wider acceptance of mental health concerns in society;
