



## Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is graced with abundant water resources including lakes, streams, and rivers; and
- WHEREAS: These waters and adjacent lands possess outstanding scenic, recreational, natural, historic, scientific, economic, and spiritual values; and
- WHEREAS: The preservation of these waters and lands is essential to continue their attractive qualities for future generations; and
- WHEREAS: Federal, state and local units of government have taken action to preserve and perfect these waters; and
- WHEREAS: In recognition of the activities planned by local units of the government, watershed associations, outdoor enthusiasts, and private citizens to promote public awareness of water resources for protection, use and enjoyment; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has taken a leading role in the prudent management and use of these water bases resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, whose common border with the State of Wisconsin, is in part a National Scenic and Recreational River, the St. Croix, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1984, to be

and encourage all citizens to take advantage of the unlimited opportunities available during the month of June to celebrate their water heritage and re-dedicate themselves to the conservation, protection, and wise use of our river resources.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
