WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota have a tradition of providing a meaningful life for all their citizens; and

WHEREAS: Persons who survive stroke and their families need the support of others in their community as they adjust to new daily living patterns; and

WHEREAS: Stroke support groups offer a caring and understanding atmosphere within which persons affected by stroke can cope with the demands of this tragedy; and

WHEREAS: Those who have survived stroke are providing leadership to those newly affected by stroke so that their recovery may be maximum; and

WHEREAS: The health care community in cooperation with persons affected by stroke are working together for a better life for stroke survivors; and

WHEREAS: The expanding Network of stroke support groups within the Courage Stroke Support Network will increase public awareness and support while uniting the efforts of persons with stroke and their families to achieve a full and meaningful life;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 9 through September 15, 1984, to be

Courage Stroke Support Network Week

In Minnesota.
