WHEREAS: Faribault Festivals, Incorporated, a nonprofit corporation, has diligently pursued the recognition of the city of Faribault's heritage through a week long celebration; and

WHEREAS: A heritage celebration instills community pride and further recognizes the quality of life in Faribault, and in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Faribault Heritage Days are designed to commemorate the city's history, foster community pride, and to recognize the many ethnic groups that comprise our community; and

WHEREAS: Alexander Faribault, founder and early settler of the city of Faribault, recognized the need of community involvement, cooperation, and future development; and

WHEREAS: The City of Faribault was incorporated as a city April 2, 1872, and has been a strong and vital community to southeastern Minnesota for 112 years;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 11 through June 17, 1984, to be
