The year 1984 marks the fortieth anniversary of the introduction of Smokey Bear as the symbol of the unique, highly-successful forest fire prevention campaign; and WHEREAS:

Smokey Bear has encouraged several generations of children across our Nation to help prevent wildfires by becoming junior forest rangers; and WHEREAS:

Smokey Bear is responsible for a great reduction in the incidence of forest fires in Minnesota and throughout the Nation; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: Smokey Bear has saved taxpayers billions of dollars in firefighting costs and timber

resources; and

Smokey Bear will continue to promote wildfire prevention among person of all ages and to protect Minnesota's timber resources for industry and outdoor recreation; WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 17 through June 23, 1984, to be

SMOKEY BEAR WEEK

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge citizens to continue to be careful with fire in our beautiful Minnesota forest areas and to follow the example set by Smokey Bear.
