



Proclamation

WHEREAS: July 28, 1984 marks the first day of the 1984 International Olympics in Los Angeles to commemorate and encourage the pursuit of excellence in physical fitness and human endeavor; and

WHEREAS: Across the country, Special Olympics activities for the physical handicapped will be held on July 28, 1984 to complement the International Olympics; and

WHEREAS: Honeywell Inc. places great value on wellness and physical fitness and encourages activities which promote good health and the strength of the human spirit; and

WHEREAS: Honeywell has sponsored a Special Olympics Family Day since 1979 to provide people of differing levels of physical ability the opportunity to share in the spirit of Olympian competition; and
