WHEREAS: More than 20,000 people in Minnesota are newspaper carriers; and

WHEREAS: These young people show extraordinary ambition and willingness to accept responsibility; and

WHEREAS: Newspaper carriers operate as independent contractors to the state's newspapers, therefore, learning how to operate a small business, as well as how to deal with people; and

WHEREAS: Newspaper carriers provide a service which makes news easily available to the public; and

WHEREAS: This effort helps to promote freedom of the press; and

WHEREAS: Each year, a special day is set aside to recognize the efforts, initiative, creativity and dedication of newspaper carriers throughout Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, October 13, 1984, to be

NEWSPAPER CARRIER DAY

in Minnesota,
