STANDARDS FOR AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION INPUT LIEN NOTIFICATION STATEMENT

1. This form is for use when filing an Agricultural Production Lien Pursuant to M.S. 514. No other form can be used for this purpose.
2. The form must meet all of the following requirements and specifications:
 - A. The size must be 8 inches by 5 inches, excluding the top perforated tab;
 - B. The form must be five carbon or carbon-less snap-out;
 - C. The first page must be between 24- and 28 pound white ledger paper, printed with black ink; and
 - C. The size of the type must not be less than 6 point.
3. A standard Agricultural Production Lien Notification Statement must be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE TO LENDER: Pursuant to M.S. 514 you hereby notified of the above described Agricultural Production Input Lien. You have 10 days from the date of receipt of this notice in which to respond with either a letter of commitment for part or all of the amount in the lien notification statement or a written refusal to issue a letter of commitment. If you fail to respond to the supplier within 10 days, an agricultural production input lien corresponding to the lien notification statement has priority over any security interest you might have in the same crops or livestock or their proceeds for the lesser of: (1) the amount stated in the lien-notification statement; (2) the unpaid retail cost of the agricultural production input identified in the lien notification statement; or (3) for livestock (with limitations).

8. The fifth page must be identical to the first page except that it must have the following language "(5) Supplier Copy" must appear at the bottom left.

9. On the back of the fifth page, beginning below the perforation, must appear the following:

INSTRUCTIONS

1. This form must be typed or printed in black so that it is legible on the white, pink, and goldenrod copies.

2. Provide the true and complete name of the person to whom the Agricultural Production Input was furnished; initials or abbreviations may not be sufficient to properly index your filing.

3. If the space provided for any items on this form is inadequate, the item(s) may be continued on additional sheets, preferably 8-1/2 inches by 11 inches. Only one copy of the additional sheets needs to be presented to the filing officer.

4. When the form is completed and signed you should remove the fourth page and send it to the lender by certified mail or another verifiable method. If there are multiple lenders you should photocopy that page and mail it to all of them. Mark the envelope "IMPORTANT LEGAL NOTICE"

5. In order to perfect the agricultural production input lien, the lien must attach and the supplier entitled to the lien must file the lien notification statement with the appropriate filing officer under the Uniform Commercial Code:

6. Original, goldenrod, and pink copies should be sent to the filing officer with the interleaved carbon paper intact (if applicable).

7. The pink copy will be stamped with the filing information and returned to you by the filing officer. If the lien is terminated, the supplier should sign the pink copy and return it to the filing officer directing him to remove the original from the files.

1. All amendments to an original agricultural production input lien notification statement should be submitted to the filing officer with a clear indication that it is an amendment of a existing filing. This indication should be placed as follows on the bottom line of the box marked For Filing Officer: AMENDMENT TO FILING NO. _____

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
