WHEREAS: Thirty thousand American suffer from Osteogenesis Imperfecta, Brittle Bones disease; and

WHEREAS: Millions of Americans are afflicted with Osteoporosis; and

WHEREAS: Society needs research into bone disease to realize progress in treatment and diagnosis and to eliminate these dread diseases, as a cause of human suffering and to improve life for its victims; and

WHEREAS: The American Brittle Bones Society, a national organization based in Pennsylvania is the vital force behind education and research; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Jaycee Women are actively engaged in a community awareness program, stimulating interest in this disease, education and research;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of August 1984, to be

AMERICAN BRITTLE BONES MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge the citizens and organizations of our state to support the efforts of the American Brittle Bones Society to effect research, education and treatment of Osteogenesis Imperfecta and Osteoporosis.
