



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Injuries received from motor vehicle accidents are the leading cause of death for Minnesota children; and

WHEREAS: Each year hundreds of additional children receive debilitating injuries such as paraplegia, epilepsy, and other serious brain injuries; and

WHEREAS: Parental vigilance and safety restraints can prevent many of these accidents and reduce the carnage on the roads; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Legislature, recognizing this serious public health problem, passed into law the Minnesota Child Passenger Protection Act; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is engaged in a comprehensive educational campaign to inform parents of this law and the hazards involved during travel;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of August 1984, to be

CHILD AUTO SAFETY MONTH

in Minnesota.
