WHEREAS: Major goals of Alpha Delta Kappa, an international honorary sorority for women educators, are to give recognition to outstanding educators, to build a fraternal fellowship among educators adding to their effectiveness in the promoting of excellence in education, and to establish high standards of education; and

WHEREAS: Alpha Delta Kappa promotes educational and charitable projects and activities enriching the lives of individuals everywhere and assists these individuals into a happy, constructive, and fulfilling life;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 8 through October 12, 1984, to be
