WHEREAS: Minnesotans have invested significantly large amounts of tax money in public schools to accomplish important learning; and

WHEREAS: The need for a solid grade and high school foundation is becoming more important with increasing emphasis on higher education; and

The understanding of other cultures, societies and economies is increasingly important as Minnesota trades and works with other nations; and WHEREAS:
