WHEREAS: It is time to awaken the spirit of cooperation and interdependence and to vow an end to the alienation that separates us; and

WHEREAS: It is time to disarm the attitudes and beliefs that have led to our current state of world conflict; and

WHEREAS: We can create our own desired future of peace and harmony by affirming our best human qualities of imagination, integrity, wisdom, humor, compassion, hope, trust, empathy, courage, joy, honesty, forgiveness, and mutual respect; with integrity of purpose we can model creative community; we can create peace and harmony by living it;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, August 5, 1984, to be

THE 39TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST NUCLEAR DEATH AT HIROSHIMA

in Minnesota, a day of commitment to world peace.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
