I. L. W. Whitson, who at this time and at all times hereinafter mentioned have been the duly constituted and qualified chief magistrate, to-wit: The Mayor of the City of Sauk Centre, in said County of Stearns, in accordance with the provisions of Section 56 of Article IV of the Constitution of the State of Minnesota, and the law of said State appurtament therefo, do hereby certify as follows, to-wit: That attached hereto and made a part hereof is a true and correct copy of certain amendments to the Charter of the said City of Sauk Centre, which amendments were framed and proposed by the Charter Commission of said City of the board of fifteen fresholders thereunto duly appointed and constituted by the District Court of said County of Stearns, and which said proposed amendments were by them delivered to the Mayor of the said City who transmitted the same to the Common Council thereof.

That said Common Council duly caused said proposed amendments to be submitted to a vote of the qualified voters of said city at an election duly called and held for that purpose on July 6th, 1926. That the results of said election were duly canvassed and declared by the Common Council of said City on July 7th, 1926 and that the said proposed amendments to said Charter were ratified and adopted at said election and as appears by said canvas by a vote of more than three-fourths of the qualified voters of said city voting at such election, and that thereupon the said proposed amendments became a part of the Charter of said city to take effect as such at the time provided by law.

In test imonybwhereof I have hereunto set my hand as the Mayor of said city and have caused this instrument to be authenticated by the

Section 11 of the Charter of the City of Sauk Centre, Minnesota is a mended and changed so as to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 11. How Conducted. The general laws of the State of Minnesota relative to elections in cities of the fourth class and relating to corrupt practices in-so-far as applicable shall go vern all general and a pecial municipal elections excepting that no pole list shall be prepared or posted prior to any such election and there shall be no prior registration of vo ters, and also except as otherwise provided in this charter, the Council shall make suitable provision for the holding of elections.

The Last paragraph of Section 97 of said Charter is amended and changed so as to read as follows, to-wit:

The Commission shall pay into the city treasury amually, to the credit of the sinking fund, a sum sufficient to defray the interest falling due in that year on the bonded indebtedness of the light and power plant or other plants under its charge. In addition the commission shall annually pay over to the city treasurer to be credited to the public utility fund a sum amounting to not less than ten per cent of gross receipts of the light and power plant to be invested by him in interest bearing certificates of deposit, which sum, together with accumulated interest, is to be available for the replacement of, or additions to the plant or machinery but not for repairs. This public utility fund may also be used for the retirement of the bonded indebtedness of the light and power plant or any other public utility or municipal bended indebtedness.

The third paragraph of Section 96 of said Charter is changed and amended so as to read as follows, to-wit:

The commission shall have no power or authority to sall, lease, rent, or in any way dispose of or incumber the plant or plants under their control, or suffer or permit such property or any part of it to come under the control of any private person or corporation whatsoever, except as, and unless, authorized thereto by a vote of a majority of the electors of said city voting upon such proposition at either a general or special election, and upon request of said commission the City Council shall submit such proposition at any general city election or, if so requested, shall call a special election for such pur pase.
