WHEREAS: Prince has established a new era in rock music with his singing and playing versatility, and with his movie, "Purple Rain"; and

WHEREAS: Prince has boosted the recording and filming industry in Minnesota with his activities; and

WHEREAS: Prince has proven that a Minnesotan can remain in Minnesota and still develop a national reputation and recognition;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, August 24, 1984, to be
