WHEREAS: The Tour of Minnesota is a sanctioned event of the United States Cycling Federation and the United States Olympic Committee; and

WHEREAS: The Tour of Minnesota offers athletes from all over the world an opportunity to compete in the only bicycle point-to-point stage race in the country; and

WHEREAS: The Tour of Minnesota celebrates the state's mix of urban centers and towns, state parks and scenic natural beauty, and wonderful community spirit along its 725 mile, 10-city route; and

WHEREAS: The economic impact of the Tour of Minnesota will be substantial in terms of additional tourism revenues for local economies; and

WHEREAS: The Tour of Minnesota has received ardent support from state and local government, corporations and small business, civic organizations and the media;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 10 through August 19, 1984, to be

in Minnesota.
