WHEREAS: The personal computer has demonstrated a significant impact as a cost-effective learning aid for school, home, and business; and


WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes that the personal computer represents a long-range solution to major educational, social and business issues;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October 1984, to be

COMPUTER LEARNING MONTH


in Minnesota.
