WHEREAS: The Minnesota Jaycee Women is an organization of young women who believe in the brotherhood of mankind and that this brotherhood transcends the sovereignty of nations; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Jaycee Women believe that government should be of laws rather than of men; and

WHEREAS: In their fight for independence, communities in the United States have established a heritage of freedom by patriotic service; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Jaycee Women are committed to a patriotic recognition of the discovery of America and the founding freedoms of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS: Jaycee women across this nation will be showing their concern, loyalty, and support for our country by a vivid and patriotic display of pride in America throughout our communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 7 through October 13, 1984, to be

in Minnesota, and urge citizens to join in the observance of this week with appropriate ceremonies and activities.
