WHEREAS: We are happy to announce that the Minority Education Recruiters and Counselors (MERC) along with the Minnesota Association of Secondary School Counselors and College Admissions Officers (MASSCCO) are holding their third annual Statewide Minority Education Fair; and

WHEREAS: Our target population includes both Minority adults and high school students in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of the fair is to increase minority awareness of the many educational opportunities available to them; and
