IN THE MATTER OF THE DETACHMENT OF CERTAIN LAND FROM THE CITY OF EAGAN AND ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF MENDOTA HEIGHTS PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 414.06

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW, AND ORDER

On July 10, 1984, the Minnesota Municipal Board received a resolution from the City of Eagan , which requested the detachment of certain property and the City of Mendota Heights, which requested the annexation of the same territory pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.061.

After review of the resolutions, the Minnesota Municipal Board hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- That a resolution supporting detachment of certain properties was received from the City of Eagan and a resolution supporting annexation of said property was received from the City of Mendota Heights.
- The resolutions contained all the information required by statute. including a description of the territory proposed for detachment and annexation, which is as follows:

That portion of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 3, Township 27 North, Range 23 West of the fourth principal meridian, Dakota County, Minnesota, lying north of Highway 494,

All that part of the east one-half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 3,

Township 27, Range 23 lying north of the northerly right-of-way of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 494,

and

All that part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3, Township 27, Range 23, lying north of the northerly right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway No. 494.

3. The area proposed for detachment is situated within the City of Eagan and abuts the municipal boundary of the City of Medota Heights.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Minnesota Municipal Board duly acquired and now has juridication of the within proceeding.
- 2. An order should be issued by the Minnesota Municipal Board concurrently detaching and annexing the area described herein.

ORDER

- 1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the property described herein in Findings of Fact 2 be, and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Eagan and annexed to the City of Mendota Heights, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
- 2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the effective date of this order is August 16, 1984.
