WHEREAS: The charity work being done by the Courage Center and the many hours of hard work and dedication being put forth by high school marching bands is well-known; and

WHEREAS: In Minnesota, as well as across the country, there has been a renewed interest and a sincere dedication to the development, improvement and preservation of quality music programs in high schools; and

WHEREAS: This dedication and hard work by high school bands has been strengthened and supported by the creation of MUSIC BOWL, a unique high school marching band contest underwritten by the Fisher Nut subsidiary of Beatrice Foods Company, for the benefit of the Courage Center, as well as the participating high school bands from throughout Minnesota;
