



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Hundreds of lives in Minnesota are saved each year by emergency medical personnel; and

WHEREAS: Advances in emergency medical care have made it possible to save these lives; and

WHEREAS: Emergency physicians, nurses and prehospital care personnel in Minnesota are highly trained to assure that more lives are saved every day; and

WHEREAS: Emergency department personnel throughout Minnesota are specialists trained to handle life- or limb-threatening illnesses and injuries requiring immediate attention, and must be available 24 hours every day of the week to all patients who need medical aid; and

WHEREAS: Emergency Medicine Week is being held to educate the citizens of Minnesota about emergency medicine;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 16 through September 22, 1984, to be

EMERGENCY MEDICINE WEEK

in Minnesota.
