WHEREAS: Our State's and our country's future in a real sense depends on the birth and rearing of unborn children by today's expectant parents; and

WHEREAS: Business and professional organizations, such as the Juvenile Products Manufacturers Association, have made great efforts to help provide expectant parents with safety information and regulations in conjunction with juvenile products as a further safeguard for our unborn population; and

WHEREAS: The quality of life we enjoy in the State of Minnesota has made our State a great place to live, a great place to work and especially a great place to raise a family;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, September 9, 1984, to be

EXPECTANT PARENT'S DAY

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge all citizens to make a sincere and significant effort to acknowledge Minnesota's future through the education, enrichment and support of the growing ranks of expectant parents.
