



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The farm is a wonderful place to live and bring up children; and

WHEREAS: There are many areas and types of equipment on each farm where accidents may occur; and

WHEREAS: The farm is recognized as a high accident rate industry; and

WHEREAS: The responsibility for safety and health on each farm falls to the farmer; and

WHEREAS: It is very important for farm people to be well prepared for emergencies such as fire, sudden illness, injury and storms; and

WHEREAS: The theme for Farm Safety Week is "Manage for Better Safety and Health."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 16 through September 22, 1984 as

F A R M S A F E T Y W E E K

and urge all Minnesota farm people to exert all caution to prevent accidents.
