The National Kinship Advisory Council has declared September 23 through September 29, WHEREAS:

1984 as Kinship Week, a time to honor the volunteers, staff and children who are in

Kinship;

NOW, THEREFORE, I. Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 23 through September 29, 1984, to be

KINSHIP WEEK

in Minnesota and I urge all citizens to acquaint themselves with the principles and objectives of the Kinship program.
