



Proclamation

WHEREAS: In Minnesota each year, more than 15,000 families suffer the loss of their children through miscarriage, stillbirth or early infant death; and

WHEREAS: The impact of such losses can be devastating for the family life, work and career, and mental, emotional and physical health of these families; and

WHEREAS: There is a great need for increased public awareness of the services that are available to support bereaved families, and a need for additional support services; and

WHEREAS: Informed family, friends, and co-workers could provide valuable support to bereaved families; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 1 through October 5, 1984, to be

PREGNANCY AND INFANT LOSS AWARENESS WEEK

in Minnesota.
