WHEREAS: We Care Week originated in Wisconsin with a group of farm women focusing on the economic problems in agriculture; and

WHEREAS: We Care Week is a means of exploring how the farm women can help each other cope with the current economic crisis in agriculture; and

WHEREAS: Farm income has been cut in half during the past ten years; and

WHEREAS: Farmers now pay more in interest than they gain in income; and

WHEREAS: Farmers are experiencing the worst cash flow crisis since the 1930's; and

WHEREAS: Farm debt is up 1,000 percent since 1970;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 9 through September 15, 1984, to be

W E C A R E W E E K

in Minnesota.
