



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Economic issues are of increasing importance to all citizens in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The ability to think critically about economic issues is essential for an economically literate society; and

WHEREAS: The education of teachers and their students is crucial for an economically literate society; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Council on Economic Education has for over twenty years, striven to increase the quality and improve the quality of economic instruction in Minnesota's schools;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, October 18, 1984, to be

ECONOMIC EDUCATION DAY

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I call upon all citizens to support economic education in the Minnesota schools and to work to advance the understanding of the American economic system and its role in the world economy.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-seventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-four, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
