WHEREAS: Minnesota industry is a leader among national industries providing unequalled quality in the products produced, and assures diligent attention to Quality Assurance, ultimately benefiting the consumer; and

WHEREAS: The resulting product quality achievements are a source of growing pride to all citizens in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The contributions made by those concerned with quality assurance have stimulated similar motivation among other citizens in whatever vocations they may be engaged in;

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota wishes to further promote the ideals of quality assurance as applied to all products for all consumers everywhere;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 24 through March 1, 1985, to be

QUALITY IMPROVEMENT WEEK

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge citizens to recognize the men and women who are involved in quality assurance achievement and who will assemble for the thirty-third annual Minnesota Quality Conference sponsored by the Minnesota section of the American Society for Quality Control.
