ORDINANCE NO. 87 , 2ND SERIES

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS
TO THE CITY OF THIEF RIVER FALLS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THIEF RIVER FALLS, MINNESOTA,
ORDAINS:

Section 1. WHEREAS, The sole owner of the following
described premises situated in the County of Pennington and
State of Minnesota, to-wit:

All that part of Government Lot Three
(3), that part of Government Lot Four
(4) and that part of the Southwest
Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$
NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Four (4), Township
One Hundred Fifty-four (154) North, of
Range Forty-three (43) West of the
Fifth Principal Meridian which lies
Westerly of the centerline of Minne-
sota Highway No. 32, containing 75.4
acres, including 11.4 acres of Highway
and Railroad right-of-way along the
Easterly 175 feet of said parcel;

has petitioned to the City Council to have such land in-
cluded within the City Limits of the City of Thief River
Falls and has filed copies of said Petition with the Muni-
cipal Board of the State of Minnesota, with the Town Board of
the Township of Rocksbury of the County of Pennington and
State of Minnesota, and with the County of Pennington and

WHEREAS, The above-described property abuts upon the
boundaries of the City of Thief River Falls, and

City of Thief River Falls and of the territory affected and the above-described premises are hereby declared annexed to the City of Thief River Falls.

Section 2. City Code Chapter 20, Listing of Uncoded Annexation Ordinances is hereby amended by addition of the foregoing ordinance to such listing.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication and filing with the Municipal Board, the Town Clerk of Rocksbury Township, the Pennington County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
