



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota's economic well-being depends on a healthy agriculture; and

WHEREAS: That well-being depends on the interaction of Minnesota farmers, agribusinesses, consumers, government, and others; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota women employed in the agricultural industry have contributed significantly to the quality of the state's food and fiber system, making the state's agriculture unparalleled in quality and diversity; and

WHEREAS: The contribution of Minnesota women in agriculture has assumed increasingly wider importance in assuring a healthy agriculture and therefore a healthy economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of November 1984, to be

MINNESOTA WOMEN IN AGRICULTURE MONTH

in Minnesota.
